

Figure Eight Descender for Climbing Rope Petzl Huit

The figure eight is used to secure and reduce friction during descent with a climbing rope. Firefighters use a figure of eight to belay on the climbing rope and descend. The figure eight allows to reduce friction during abseiling with a climbing rope and control the speed of abseiling.

The figure eight is connected to the fire belt and a climbing rope is passed through it. It is necessary to tighten the rope before descending, and when we start the descent, by slowly releasing the rope through the figure of eight, you control the speed and the way of descending the climbing rope.

Other applications: speleology, sport climbing, work at height.

Description

- Square shape helps reduce rope twist and girth hitch formation
- Compact and lightweight
- Small hole can be used with thin ropes if necessary, or as a belay plate
