

Fire Flapper for Wildland Fires

The Fire Flapper is used as an auxiliary tool in extinguishing open space fires.

In order to extinguish the marginal parts of the fire affected by a small flame, firefighters usually use flappers in addition to fire backpacks . The Fire Flapper is handled in such a way that the firefighter suffocates the flames with mechanical impact (strokes) and thus extinguishes the fire. It is useful in areas where there is no water or the water supply is very difficult.

When extinguishing fires with a flapper, make sure that you are at a safe distance from the flames and be sure to use protective firefighting equipment for interventions in open fires.

Characteristics:

- Proven model with ten spring steel compartments
- Galvanized sheet steel head
- The separately supplied handle is attached using a quick-release fastener
