

Firefighter Leather Gloves Boxer

Boxer firefighting leather gloves can be used as technical gloves in firefighting and rescue. Due to heat shrinkage and skin reaction, **they are not suitable for direct contact with fire.**

Boxer gloves offer excellent comfort and good grip. They provide good protection against mechanical risks (according to EN 388: 2003) and are additionally sewn with Kevlar seams. As they are not suitable for direct access to open flames, they can be used in post-extinguishing fire-fighting interventions and technical interventions to remove rubble and building materials.

Materials:

- Natural cow grain leather
- Hydrophobic leather
- Kevlar stitches

Other features:

- Color: Gray
- Red reflective strip on cuff, 25 mm wide
- Length: 35 cm
- Buckles that can be used to tie gloves and hang on a carabiner or belt
- Standards: EN 388: 2003, EN 420: 2003 + A1: 2009, category II
- Application: firefighters, industry, warehouse...
