



## **Firefighter Leather Gloves Boxer**

Boxer firefighting leather gloves can be used as technical gloves in firefighting and rescue. Due to heat shrinkage and skin reaction, they are not suitable for direct contact with fire.

Boxer gloves offer excellent comfort and good grip. They provide good protection against mechanical risks (according to EN 388: 2003) and are additionally sewn with Kevlar seams. As they are not suitable for direct access to open flames, they can be used in post-extinguishing fire-fighting interventions and technical interventions to remove rubble and building materials.

## **Materials:**

- Natural cow grain leather
- Hydrophobic leather
- Keylar stitches

## Other features:

• Color: Gray

• Red reflective strip on cuff, 25 mm wide

• Length: 35 cm

• Buckles that can be used to tie gloves and hang on a carabiner or belt

• Standards: EN 388: 2003, EN 420: 2003 + A1: 2009, category II
