

Seattle low cut occupational shoes

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Seattle low cut occupational shoes provide protection and comfort for your feet in the workplace. The materials they are made of and the way they are designed, allow you to step safely and comfortably at all time.

Seattle work shoes are a model without a protective steel toe cap, with antistatic and antislip outsole resistant to fuel oils. They can be used for activities when there is no risk of serious foot injuries, because there is no high exposure to mechanical risks.

The upper part is made of high-quality brushed cowhide, with a puncture-resistant Kevlar insole.
